Sites Update

Paediatric sites in progress

- Canberra Hospital, ACT (2018)- ethics approved, DPMS installation still in discussion with ACT Health, data expected Aug 2019
- Christchurch Hospital, NZ – ethics approved, DPMS installed, data expected Feb 2019, no payments
- Dunedin Hospital, NZ – ethics approved for SDHB, data expected Feb 2019, no payments
- Royal Hobart Hospital, TAS (2018) – Tasmania Health did not approve DPMS as state-wide diabetes clinical system, discussions continuing
- Flinders Medical Centre, SA - DPMS installed, not an ADDN site this phase

NDSS CGM Evaluation Update

Report

- Final CGM Evaluation Interim Report submitted to Government and officially accepted on 9 October 2018.
- Full Year Report due in March 2019. A statistician engaged by JDRF is performing preliminary analysis of the current CGM data.

MOU/agreements

- A Data Request form was submitted to the Data Release Advisory Panel on 2 October as required by Government
- Pending approval, MOUs will be signed between JDRF and DA/NDSS to link NDSS data, and between DA/NDSS with BioGrid for the transfer of NDSS data. JDRF will sign a service agreement with BioGrid governing data linkage.

QoL

- The CGM Working Group continues working on a QoL questionnaire and protocol (this is currently unfunded).

ADDN Sustainability

Assessment of the potential future directions for the Australasian Diabetes Data Network (ADDN)

JDRF commissioned Dr Rachel Swift (Swift Outcomes) to write a report after consultation with selected JDRF personnel, ADDN PIs, APEG, ADS, BioGrid, project staff and two international T1D registry experts

- This report was circulated and discussed at the last Steering Committee meeting in September.
- One key recommendation is to hold an all-day ADDN Strategy Meeting early in 2019. JDRF will be coordinating and funding this event, likely in March 2019. Further updates will be provided in the coming months.
- Funding update – JDRF has reviewed the acquittals from organisations and a reconciliation of the budget completed

Update

New version 4.1

A new version of the ADDN Data Dictionary v4.1 has been released. This was approved by the Steering Committee at the meeting on 21 September 2018.

Summary of key changes:

1. Changed Gender value from Undetermined to Indeterminate
2. Changed range for BMI
3. Insulin Regimen - Added new values 'Do-It-Yourself' (DIY) and 'Hybrid Closed Loop' (HCL)
4. Pump Make and Model combined into single Insulin Pump with predefined values
5. Removed CGM Used
6. Renamed Continuous Glucose Monitoring to CGM Type
7. Renamed and redefined HospHONK to Hyperosmolar Hyperglycaemic State (HHS)
8. Corrected the measurement for AER
9. New fields added to Patient:
pH and Bicarbonate
10. New fields added to Visit:
NPDR, PDR, Maculopathy, Cataract, Cataract Extraction, Focal Laser, Panretinal Photocoagulation, Vitreal Injection, eGFR (calculated)
11. Guidelines on how to enter test results updated in Guide for Use

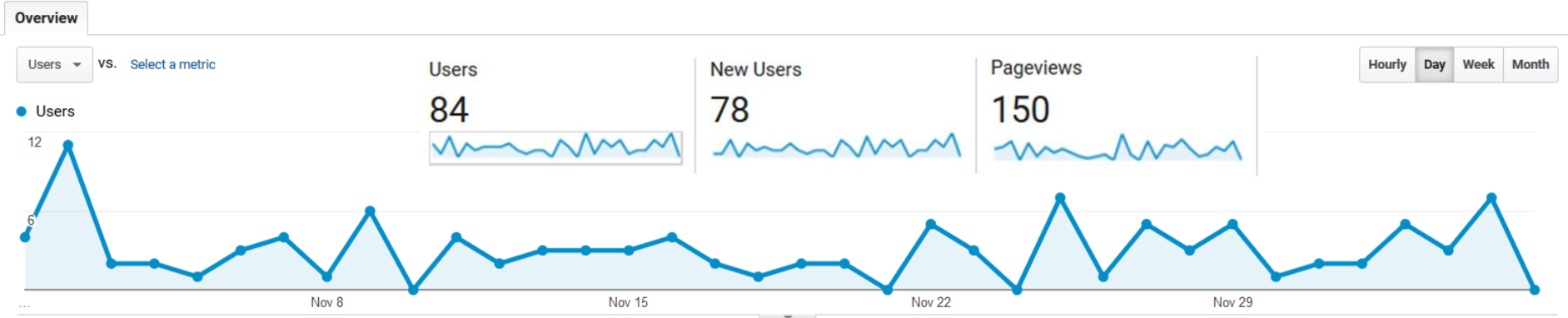

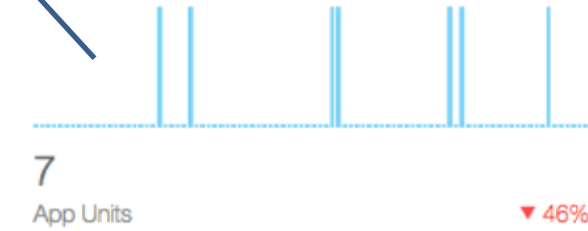
